

SILVERCARE SERVICES

The monthly care level fee is based on the resident’s score from the initial assessment. A Registered Nurse (RN) will assign point values to a resident’s activities of daily living and behaviors. The level of care assessment is also used in developing the resident’s service plan. Re-evaluation of the resident’s level of care and service plan will occur on a regularly scheduled basis or upon a change in condition.

SERVICES INCLUDED IN ALL LEVELS OF CARE

- Resident Assistant available 24/7
- Nurse coordination of service plan
- Nurse visit every other month
- Reflections Director oversight
- Nurse on-call availability by phone 24/7
- Licensed Nurse on-site 7 days a week
- Care conferences
- Nurse assessment
- Medication management (with preferred pharmacy)

Resident Assistants to perform personal care including but not limited to:

- dressing, bathing, grooming
- medication administration
- meal assistance/hydration
- escorts to meals/activities
- laundry (up to 4 loads/week)
- ambulation/mobility
- behavior monitoring
- vital signs and weights
- safety checks
- toileting
- transferring
